RPO BUSINESS

Item 4A: Recommend LOSRPO Final Regional Impact Local Input Point assignments

NCDOT Strategic Office of Prioritization, NCDOT Divisions, RPO’s and MPO’s across the state are well into Prioritization 7, P7 or SPOT 7. Quantitative scores were released May 24th as well as the DRAFT Statewide Programed Projects. The DRAFT Regional Impact Local Input Point assignment list was presented at the June LOSRPO TCC meeting and recommended to the RPO TAC. The Regional Impact Local Input Point assignment list has been available for public comment on the RPO website and has been advertised in the Mtn. Express. There have been no comments received as of the drafting of this agenda.

The final Regional Impact point assignment will be adopted at the TAC meeting on August 15th. The Regional Impact Local Input Point List can be reviewed at [Land of Sky RPO Regional Impact LIP List](#)

The tables below demonstrate the criteria that Land of Sky RPO used to assign Regional Impact Local Input Points in SPOT 7.0.

These are projects that have been previously selected for funding through Prioritization 3.0 (P3.0), Prioritization 4.0 (P3.0), or Prioritization 5.0 (P5.0). The input will be used to assist the STIP Unit when adjusting schedules to meet federal and state fiscal constraint requirements.
