#### APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA

Chair Kevin Ensley requested approval of the agenda and the consent agenda, which included the May 2025 meeting minutes, and the TAC agenda.

Mac Morrow moved to approve the agenda and the consent agenda, which included the August 2025 Meeting Minutes and the TAC agenda. Chuck McGrady seconded the motion which passed unanimously upon a roll call vote.

# LAND OF SKY RPO TAC BUSINESS <a href="Item-4A">Item 4A</a>: Adoption of the LOSRPO Prioritization 8.0 Project List</a>

The North Carolina Board of Transportation at their July 2025 meeting adopted the 2026 - 2035 The State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The STIP is North Carolina's document that reflects planned transportation investments over a ten-year period. The STIP describes each project, has a schedule for implementation, funding sources, and estimated costs.


NCDOT updates the STIP on a two-year cycle based on projects selected for funding from the NCDOT Prioritization process. This is the process in North Carolina that helps determine the majority of transportation improvements across the State. The process is dictated by the <a href="Strategic Transportation Investments Act (STI) 2012">Strategic Transportation Investments Act (STI) 2012</a> and is generally designed to be a data-driven, transparent process to determine what transportation projects are funded or not. The adoption of the new STIP triggers the beginning to the next Prioritization cycle, **P8.0**. RPO's, MPO's and NCDOT Divisions work with local partners to select projects to be submitted for consideration for funding, (inclusion in the next STIP). Projects from all modes are submitted and will be scored based on the mode, facility type, proposed improvements, and compete for any available funding.

The outcome of Prioritization 8.0, P8.0 will be the 2028 – 2037 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

Projects submitted in the Land of Sky RPO planning area can be RPO submittals, LOSRPO has 11 submittal slots for each mode in P 8.0. Division 13 or 14 submittals, each division get 10 submittal slots for each mode in P8.0. And carryover projects, LOSRPO has no carryover projects in P8.0.

There are several steps in the prioritization process. See the illustration below with RPO tasks circled in **BLUE**: We are currently at Step one Project Submittal.

Mac Morrow moved to adopt the LOSRPO Prioritization 8.0 with expectation there might be some small changes. Matt Wecthel seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously upon a roll call vote.

## <u>Item 4B: NCDOT Functional Classification Change Request form post 2020 Census:</u> Statewide Functional Reclassification Updates

Functional classification is the process of grouping streets and highways into classes according to the character of service they are intended to provide and include evaluation of annual average daily traffic (AADT) data, speed limit, length, and other roadway characteristics. Accurate roadway functional classification ensures that federal aid funds are allocated where they are needed most. The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) Transportation Planning Division (TPD) is responsible for

processing updates to the Federal Functional Classification System in North Carolina every 10 years in partnership with planning organizations (MPO's & RPO's) for submission to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for approval. Functional classification for roadways is categorized into the 7 classifications noted below:

- 1 Interstate
- 2 Freeway
- 3 Other Principal Arterial
- 4 Minor Arterial
- 5 Major Collector
- 6 Minor Collector
- 7 Local

For the Land of Sky RPO, an internal NCDOT committee identified the roadways. Then TPD worked with RPO, MPO and Division staff to refine the attached list for functional classification updates placed in front of you today.
